

SOUTHSIDE ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE
Residential – Time of Use
Schedule A-TOU

Availability:

Available, on a voluntary and limited basis, to residential Members in all territory served by the Cooperative, subject to the Terms and Conditions of the Cooperative on file with the Virginia State Corporation Commission, and where the Member takes service at one delivery point through one kilowatt-hour meter.

Applicability:

Applicable to residential Members otherwise served under Schedule A. This rate shall be limited to the availability of appropriate meters and may be limited further by the saturation and/or impact on the Cooperative's electric system of members utilizing this rate schedule in a general area. Net Metering Members are not eligible for this rate.

Character of Service:

Single phase, 60 cycles, at a secondary nominal voltage of 120/240 volts.

Monthly Rate:

I. Distribution Delivery Service Charges

Consumer Delivery Charge:

Single Phase @ \$26.00 per month

Energy Delivery Charges:

First 100 kWh delivered @ \$0.04789 per kWh

Over 100 kWh delivered @ \$0.04229 per kWh

Demand Delivery Charge:

All kW Delivered @ \$0.10 per kW

II. Energy Supply Service Charges:

All On-Peak kWh – June - September @ \$0.30952 per kWh

All On-Peak kWh – October - May @ \$0.16158 per kWh

All Off-Peak kWh @ \$0.04129 per kWh

Each kWh sold is also subject to increase or decrease under provisions of the Cooperative's Power Cost Adjustment Clause, Schedule PCA-1.

Schedule A-TOU

Billing Demand:

The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt integrated demand established by the Member for any 60-minute clock hour period during the month for which the bill is rendered as indicated or recorded by a meter.

Definition of On-peak and Off-Peak kWh:

- a. On-Peak kWh – For the months of June through September, on-peak kWh is defined as kWh used between the hours of 3:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. on weekdays, excluding Memorial Day, July 4th, and Labor Day. For the months of October through May on-peak kWh is defined as kWh used on weekdays between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m., and between 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m., excluding Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day.
- b. Off-Peak kWh is defined as all kWh not included in (a) above.

Minimum Monthly Distribution Delivery Charge:

The minimum monthly charge for distribution delivery service under this schedule shall be the Consumer Delivery Charge where 15 kVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For members requiring in excess of 15 kVA of transformer capacity, the minimum monthly charge shall be increased by \$1.00 per each kVA in excess of 15 kVA.

Special Terms & Conditions:

- a) Motors having a rated capacity in excess of 10 horsepower will only be permitted on single phase service upon approval of the Cooperative. The Cooperative reserves the right to reject the use of motors exceeding 10 horsepower upon finding such installations would interfere with the quality of service rendered to other Members of the Cooperative.
- b) The Cooperative reserves the right to refuse service where the capacity of the Member's load justified three-phase service on an economic basis.
